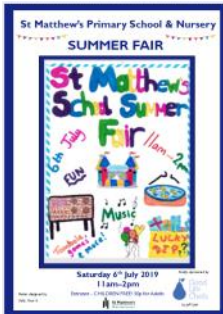


SUMMER FAIR - SATURDAY 6th JULY
