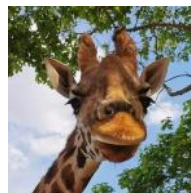

ATTENDANCE

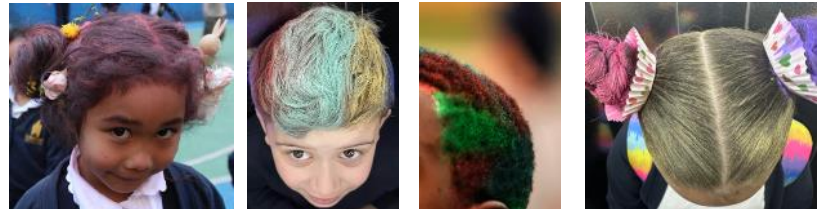

Our wonderful St Matthew's family raised over £120 for Comic Relief.

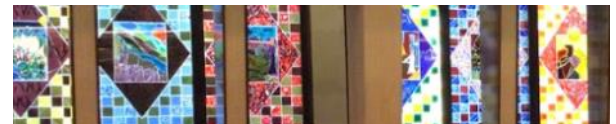
