Please remember to send your child to school with a water bottle each day, sun hat/cap and to have applied sun cream before they come to school (not at the school gate and please do not send it into to school).

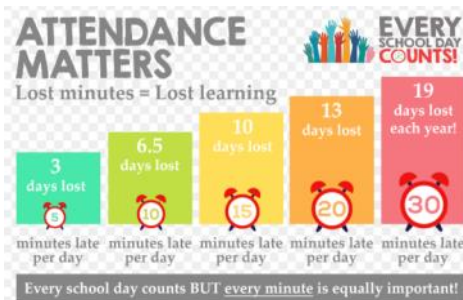


### Sports Day

**Please ensure that your child is in school on time each day. The school gates open at 08:45. Every minute late is lost learning.**

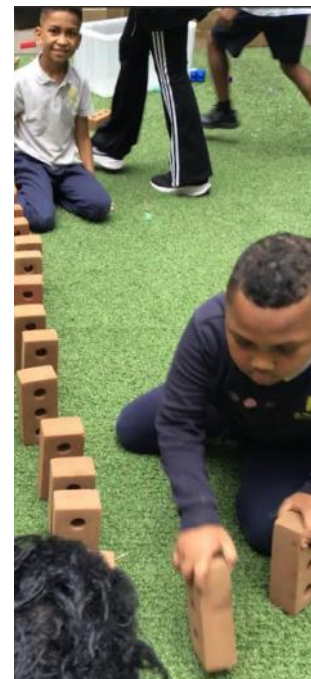


## Attendance
