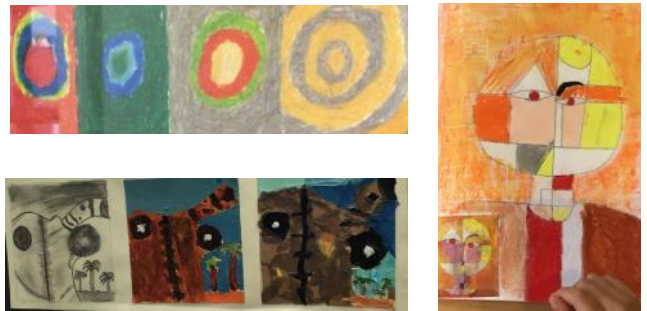
Last week's Non Uniform Day raised **£117!**
